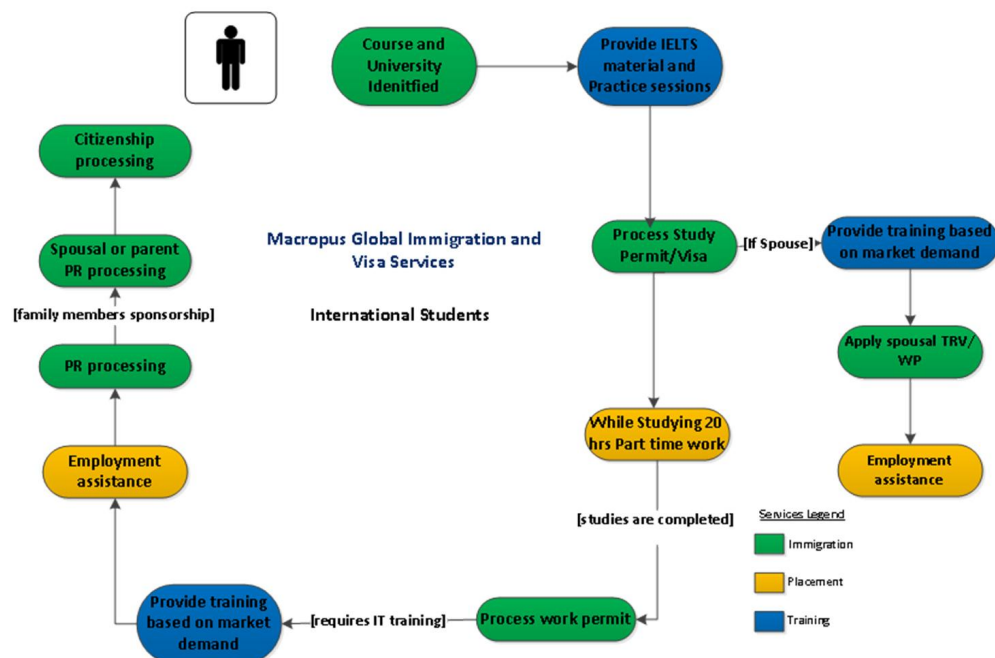

- Find a suitable program, college or university within student budget and other requirements and process study permit/student visa.

## Study Scenarios in Canada

### Scenario 1: Proper Professional Education & Settle in Canada

- Courses like MBA, MA, MSc, M.Com, other Post Graduation Degree Programs and Doctorates
- Duration of study: Varies from 2 years for Masters to 3-5 years for doctorates
- Fee for International Students varies between CA\$25,000 to CA\$70,000 depending on the Institution and Program
- Academic requirements: Baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.0 (70% and above), have worked or volunteered in the field of application.
- English Language Requirements: \*\*
  - IELTS (Academic) - score of 6.5 or higher with a minimum band score of 6.0
  - TOEFL - score of 88 or higher (iBT) with no section below 20
  - PTE - score of 61 with 60 in writing
  - Note: GRE and GMAT for certain university and program based.
- Settlement in Canada: 3 years PGWP, PR and Citizenship
- Some provinces may have the option to apply PR under "Masters Graduate Stream"

### Scenario 2: Gateway to Settle in Canada

- Courses: Fulltime post-secondary studies such as Undergraduate and Postgraduate diplomas, Certificate programs, Degrees, and Masters.
- Duration of study: Minimum 12 months to 4 years depends on the program
- Fees varies between \$15,000 to \$35,000 depending on the University and Program
- Academic requirements: Grade 12 for Undergraduate diplomas and Bachelor's degree for Postgraduate diplomas, Certificate programs, degrees or Masters.
- English Language Requirements: \*\*
  - IELTS Academic with an overall minimum score of 6.0 (with no single test score below 5.5)
  - TOEFL - score of 80 or higher (iBT) with no section below 20
  - PTE - score of 60 and above
- Settlement in Canada: PGWP minimum same length of the study program and max up to 3 years, depends on program and college and later PR and Citizenship

### Scenario 3: Economical way to come to Canada and explore options to settle down

- Courses: Fulltime Post-secondary studies of at least 8 months in duration such as Certificate programs and Diplomas
- Duration of study: Minimum 8 month to 16 month depends on the program
- Fees varies between \$10,000 to \$15,000 depending on the University and Program
- Academic requirements: Diplomas, Certificate programs or a Bachelor's degree
- English Language Requirements: \*\*
  - IELTS (Academic) - score of 5.5 or higher with a minimum band score of 5.0
- Settlement in Canada: PGWP 8 months to 1 year. Explore options to find a job or business then apply for PR and Citizenship

### Scenario 4: Exchange Programs and Memorandum of Understanding between Federal Governments

- Courses: Certificate programs, Bachelor's degree, Post Baccalaureate diplomas, Master's degree and Doctorate Programs.
- Academic requirements: Depends on the program & Institutions
- English Language Requirements: Depends on the program
- Settlement in Canada: NO - they have to return to home country

**Note:** Requirements and Fee structure varies with time according to Institutions.
